

## St. Vincent de Paul School Tuition Rates for 2009/2010

Tuition covers only a portion of the cost of educating your children at St. Vincent de Paul School. The generosity of the parishioners of St. Vincent de Paul Church enables us to offer the current tuition schedule. This schedule is divided into the following categories. Tuition status will be reviewed at registration each year.

**TUITION RATE A:** will apply to registered parish families with **returning elementary students** who meet all the requirements outlined in our school handbook. These include:

1. Child has received sacraments appropriated to his/her level of maturity, i.e., has been baptized and, if she/he has been prepared for and has received First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.
2. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) attend Eucharist regularly at St. Vincent de Paul Parish/any parish of the Northwester deanery without a Catholic school.
3. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) support St. Vincent de Paul Parish/any parish of the Northwestern deanery without a Catholic school through regular, identifiable (e.g. stewardship envelope or check) contributions to the offertory collection and building fund appropriate to the family's income.

**Note:** Qualification for this category will be based on the child's sacramental records and on contribution records as recorded by the parish office, and will be reviewed annually.

**TUITION RATE B:** will apply to individuals in the following circumstances:

1. Applies to parents/guardians who are registered members of St. Vincent de Paul Parish or a neighboring parish and have a child **entering** grades Kindergarten through 8 who is the first member of his/her immediate family to enter the elementary portion of the school.
2. Applies to parents/guardians who are registered members of a Catholic Parish other than St. Vincent de Paul Church/ any parish of the Northwestern deanery without a Catholic school.
3. Applies to parents/guardians who are registered members of St. Vincent de Paul Parish/any parish of the Northwestern deanery without a Catholic school, but fail to meet one or more of the three criteria stated in the "Frequently Asked Questions" sheet for Rate A.

**TUITION RATE C:** will apply to all Non-Catholic Families.
