

Recent Achievements of Our Students

- Duke University Talent Identification Program — In 2008, 50% of 7th graders and 32% of 4th and 5th graders qualified for this prestigious program which identifies academically talented students based on high standardized test scores (top 5%).
- Accelerated Reader — 7th graders have *average* reading level of 11th grade; 50% of 7th graders from 2005-2008 were reading at or above college level.
- Odyssey of the Mind — A SVDP team qualified for the World Finals in 2008 and was the highest scoring team in Northwest Arkansas.
- Science Fair — In 2008, a SVDP student won overall best 7th grade entry at regional competition, and 2 students won 1st place in category, 2 won honorable mention.

Pre-Kindergarten Program

St. Vincent de Paul School offers an enriching, faith-filled program (half day or full day) that helps prepare 4 and 5 year olds and their families for kindergarten.

Elementary School (grades K - 5)
